Golf Tournament Details

Held on July 14, 2009, the 6th Annual Strong Kids Golf Tournament promises to be another great day of fabulous golf play. Guests can begin to arrive as early as 11 a.m. to prepare for the outing and use the practice area and clubhouse. You can also visit The ACE Club gift shop.

The ACE Club staff will personally see that your clubs are cared for when you arrive and you will be assigned a golf cart. YMCA Staff will ensure that you are checked-in and that you have a schedule for the day and a great give-away bag. Expect to participate in a fabulous raffle.

Lunch begins at 12 p.m. on The Outdoor Pavilion and will feature a full course lunch including sandwich wraps, New York style subs, tomato pie, salads, fresh fruit and dessert. On the course you can expect non alcoholic beverages and snacks after #9 green and before #10 tee. Following your day of golf, enjoy a premium bar and delicious hors d'oeuvres. Dinner is Classic American Cuisine and will feature a steakhouse buffet complete with steaks to Order, BBQ ribs, grilled salmon, corn on the cob, and salads. The event is business casual and guests can wear appropriate attire for cocktails and dinner.

About: The ACE Club

The ACE Club is a serene and secluded 311-acre environment that is easily accessible from Center City Philadelphia, enabling ease of access by all modes of transportation and featuring an on-site heliport. The design, engineering and maintenance strategy make the course environmentally friendly, earning the elite Silver Signature Series designation in the Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Program. There is a state-of-the-art practice area where members and guests can refine their game via an outstanding long game range with short game practice areas, video and computerized swing analysis, and instruction equipment. Club Guests

Upon arriving at the club, guests should proceed directly to the bag drop/valet area under the porte cochere. Here you will be greeted by both YMCA staff and club employees who will assist you with your golf bag and check-in procedures. Proper golf attire is required for all players:

- Shoes with metal spikes or cleats are prohibited.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- "Bermuda" length shorts are recommended. No cargo shorts or slacks are permitted. Shorts may be no more than 4" above the knee. Tennis shorts are prohibited.
- Denim blue jeans are not permitted on the golf course or practice areas.
- Men must wear a shirt with a traditional collar or current fashion collar. Tee shirts are not acceptable.
- Women are permitted to wear sleeveless golf attire.
- Sweatshirts are permitted.
- Men must wear shirts tucked in.
- Caps must be worn in the traditional manner with the bill forward.

Gratuities are prohibited at the club. Cell phone use is permitted. Please be considerate of others when using a cell phone.

The Course

The ACE Club is designed by World Golf Hall of Famer and Grand Slam champion Gary Player. Mr. Player has created a masterpiece, incorporating rolling topography, meandering streams, shimmering lakes, vast swatches of mature trees, open spaces, pristine wetland habitat, natural rock outcroppings and historic architectural sites. The result is a truly sublime course featuring 18 magnificent holes, each presenting a strategic option-true to Mr. Player's design philosophy. Playable and challenging for golfers of every skill level, the course ranges from 5,200 yards from the forward tees to a massive 7,500 yards at the tips. It's a work of art that's best appreciated in person, club in hand, companions alongside.

Directions

The ACE Club is located on Ridge Pike and Manor Road, Lafayette Hill, PA 19444

From Philadelphia International Airport: Follow I-95 South to I-476 North (Plymouth Meeting). You will travel on I-476 North for 18 miles, exiting at Conshohocken, which will be Exit 18A. At end of ramp, turn right onto Ridge Pike and proceed for 3.2 miles to the seventh traffic light, which will be at Manor Road. Turn right here onto Manor Road. Drive 400 yards and turn right into the property.

From the South: Follow I-95 North to I-476 North (Plymouth Meeting). Follow the directions above.

From Southern New Jersey: Cross the Delaware River by way of either the Walt Whitman or Ben Franklin Bridge, then follow I-76 West (Schuylkill Expressway toward Valley Forge). Take the I-476 North exit toward Plymouth Meeting. Follow the directions above from Exit 18A to The ACE Club.

From Norristown/Exit 333 Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276): Bear right when exiting the toll booth onto Germantown Pike (Eastbound). Proceed for 1.8 miles to the third traffic light, then turn right onto Joshua Road. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Ridge Pike and proceed for 1.5 miles to the third light, which will be at Manor Road. Turn right onto Manor Road and drive 400 yards. Turn right into The ACE Club.

From the North: Take the Northeast Extension of the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-476) South to the exit for the East-West section of the Turnpike (I-76 and I-276). Proceed West for one-half mile to the Norristown exit, which will be Exit 333. Follow the above directions from the toll booth.

From the West: Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276) to the Norristown exit, which is Exit 333 (formerly Exit 25). Follow the above directions from the toll booth.
