


The new Program Finder on our website allows you to filter programs based on what you're looking for.

## You can now filter programs by: ☑ Location ☑ Age ☑ Day & Time ☑ Category


Plus, you can search using specific keywords and sort the results alphabetically, by start date, and more.




#### **DESKTOP VIEW**

- **✓** Location



To view pricing on a mobile device, click on the item you are interested in. This will display pricing and the program description.






### BOOKMARKING PROGRAMS

When browsing programs you can bookmark them to easily remember all the programs you are interested in by clicking on the blue and white bookmark icon.

- View all your bookmarked programs by clicking the blue bookmark item on the right side of the screen. This opens a small window where you can keep track of everything you saved.
- Keep in mind, bookmarks do not reserve your spot in a program, this is just a feature to help keep track of programs you are interested in. You will need to register for each bookmarked program to secure a spot.
- All bookmarks will be deleted automatically after 5 days.
